

Toronto Police Service (TPS) – Parking Enforcement Unit

The most effective way to report illegal or nuisance parking is by submitting a Parking Complaint Report online through the Toronto Police Service (TPS) website:

What You Need to Know:

(1) Choose the Correct Category:

Select the appropriate violation type (e.g. fire route blocked, vehicle on private property, obstructing driveway, etc.). There are 6 types of violation. This helps Parking Enforcement Officers respond faster and more effectively.



(2) Presence Required On-Site:

Someone must be physically present at the scene of the incident. This could be:

- Security staff
- Superintendent
- Tenant or Unit Owner
- Property Manager or Administrator
- Board Member
- Cleaner or Staff

(3) Follow-Up Expected:

The TPS Parking Enforcement Unit will call the reporting party to confirm and coordinate the response. Please keep your phone nearby after submitting the report.

Who Can File a Complaint?

Anyone can submit a parking complaint — whether you're a resident, employee, property manager, or a visitor witnessing an active violation within Toronto.
